Position Overview

This position will be able to undertake a varied list of food preparation and sanitization of the kitchen, while ensuring that all policies and procedures are implemented. **Weekend availability desired; rotating schedule preferred. 20-25 hours/week.**

Areas of Responsibility:

- Prepare meals according to the menu, following recipe and production requirements.
- Maintain cleanliness of kitchen and dining areas.
- Monitor and help maintain inventory.
- Communicates Food Service needs/updates to supervisor.
- Reports any health and safety concerns to the supervisor.
- Serves as a team member and performs tasks both apparent and delegated.
- Other duties as assigned.
